


Q1: Indicate what type of residence you have on Bob Lake.











Q6: In a typical year how many weeks and/or weekends do you spend at the lake in each season? (Skip to question 9 if you are a permanent resident.)






















Q18: Do you own a boat requiring a boat launch?


Q19: Are you a boat owner requiring access to a public boat launch?


Q20: Where do you store your boat?










Q26: What waste disposal system(s) do you use?














Q37: Would you support/participate in social or recreational activities organized by the Bob Lake Association?


